



*Leopards are the only cats that consistently cache their kills in trees. These kills, which can weigh up to 125 kg, are hauled into a nearby tree to avoid being lost to competitors such as lions and hyenas. This leopard, which I saw in Seronera in the Serengeti National Park in Tanzania,*

*pauses to catch its breath before starting to feed. I was fascinated by the striking abstract shape of the dark acacia tree against the plain sky and the almost sculptural beauty of the dead impala.*
