What is the Saturday Stream Snapshot Program?

On the Second Saturday of every month between 8—10 a.m., trained citizens collect water samples from their neighborhood streams in the Lower Little Miami Watershed. Choose your own site or we'll suggest one! These samples are transported to our Greenacres River Lab where volunteers under the supervision of trained lab analysts process them for nutrients, sediment, and bacteria using Standard Methods approved by US EPA. Conductivity, pH, and Turbidity are analyzed with meters. Total phosphate and Nitrate-Nitrogen are measured using Hach reagents and a spectrophotometer. Fecal coliforms are measured using membrane filtration and cultured in a water bath. The lab operates under a QA/QC plan and participates in Ohio EPA's Credible Data Program. The data is entered into the Little Miami Volunteer Database (<http://lmr-mc-database.daap.uc.edu/lmr/>). These data can be used in watershed planning and protection activities and to identify water quality problems. In addition to processing samples, check the schedule on this flyer for dates and times of our Macroinvertebrate sampling. And CQHEI Trainings!

Macroinvertebrate Sampling Training will be offered 6/14, and 9/13 at 1:00 p.m. New Citizen Habitat Quality Evaluation Trainings (CQHEI) will be held 5/10 and 10/11 at 3 p.m.
