HOW TO REGISTER

Registration is online only. If you experience an issue with online registration, please let us know by emailing camp@green-acres.org or calling (513) 898-3262. All camps require pre-registration and payment at the time of registration. Campers will recieve one camp shirt when registering for one or more (non-equine) camps.

WAITLIST

Camps do offer waitlists and operate on a "first come, first serve" basis.

CANCELLATION AND CAMP TRANSFER POLICIES

Cancellations will be refunded minus a processing fee of \$25 per camp until June 1, 2020. After June 1, 2020, no refunds are offered. If you change your mind on which camps you want to attend, each camper is allowed one transfer free of charge. If there is a difference in the price of the camp you wish to transfer to, you will be credited or debited the difference.

ATTENDING CAMP

- At pick-up, campers are required to be picked up promptly at the end time of camp each day. Children must be signed in and out each day by a designated adult. Please bring a picture ID to pick-up. On the first day of camp please provide a list of approved adults that may pick up your child. If there is an emergency preventing you from picking up your camper on time, please call (513) 898-3262.
- Closed-toe shoes are required and we ask that parents make sure their child is dressed appropriately for the weather and camp's activities.
- Bug spray and sunscreen: Our staff cannot apply these products to campers. Please apply them to your camper before they are dropped off at camp.
- We highly recommend sending your campers with a refillable water bottle.
- Staff cannot administer medication to your child.
- Our staff are certified in Basic First Aid. Our practice is to administer general first aid (band-aids and ice packs). In case of an emergency, 911 will be called as well as the parent/guardian or emergency contacts provided during registration.

GREENIES EQUINE CAMP

Greenacres Equine Center's Greenies Camp is an introduction to the Art of Horsemanship.

We are dedicated to safety and strive for quality in everything we do. This camp is an introductory level

camp for riders who have had little or no English riding instruction. Riders participating in this camp range from those who have never ridden to those who have ridden on trail rides and at friends' homes but are limited in their technical knowledge. Campers will learn basic horsemanship though mounted and unmounted lessons. This includes, but is not limited to: riding, leading, grooming, tacking, and general horse care. This camp is designed to prepare riders to join Spring/Fall Sessions of lessons at Greenacres Equine Center.


