



Greenacres 2022 Summer Camp COVID-19 Guidelines

Guardians of our campers have reviewed the following guidelines regarding COVID-19 with their children and the drop-off/pick-up point person, if applicable, prior to camp:

Greenacres Foundation (“GAF”) is monitoring and following all guidelines put in place by health organizations. Be aware these are subject to change as we monitor and comply with U. S. Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Ohio and Hamilton County Guidelines. Greenacres Foundation and all wholly owned subsidiaries of Greenacres have put reasonable, preventative measures in place to reduce the spread of COVID-19. In order to provide the safest experience for your family, GAF requires all guests to adhere to the following:

- Greenacres Foundation asks that all of our guests self-monitor their symptoms, act responsibly, and stay home if they do not feel well and/or have a temperature above 100 degrees F.
- While wearing a mask during camp is a personal choice, all individuals attending camp are encouraged to wear a mask or face covering while indoors with the exception of eating and drinking.
- Guests are asked to wash hands often and adhere to sanitation practices while on Greenacres property. Access to soap and water or hand sanitizer will be available.
- All high touch areas will be regularly sanitized.
- Per Hamilton County Health Department, water fountains that have a water crest of 2 inches or higher than the mouth piece will be available for use. Please bring a personal water bottle.
- Camp will be held outside and/or in well ventilated, open-air spaces as much as possible. Please dress appropriately for the weather.
- Anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 should follow CDC’s guidelines for community exposure.
